The Governor is also pleased to further declare that District Magistrate of the concerned district shall be the Appointing Authority for these ICPS Contractual Staff and the Director of Child Rights and Trafficking, West Bengal, shall be Appointing Authority for Kolkata District only.

The selection procedure for the recruitment of different staff under ICPS pattern as mentioned above shall be based on fifty (50) children as one unit. The member Secretary will convene the meeting as and when desired by the Chairperson.
